**\*\*\*Important Show Information\*\*\***

- Dress Rehearsal & Finale Practice will be held on Friday, January 15 from 4:45-7:15pm.
- Finale Practice will begin promptly at 4:45pm and Dress Rehearsal will begin at 5:15pm on Rink B
- At the beginning of Dress Rehearsal, soloists, duets and trios please turn in one copy of your music and loan a second copy to the videographer so he can capture a high quality copy of your music for use in the DVD.
- Arrive at the rink by 2:45pm Saturday, January 16 and Sunday, January 17
- Tickets are currently available in the cashier's booth at Ice World
- Carpooling to the rink the day of the show is highly recommend since there is limited parking
- Be sure your skater gets a good night's rest and eats a healthy meal before the show. A tired and hungry skater will not perform his/her best!
- Have your skater dressed in the costume he/she wears first before arriving to the rink. The skating order is posted on the bulletin board under the figure skating section (near the Pro Room). Be sure to bring all costumes if your skater performs in multiple numbers.
- See your skater's choreographer if you have any questions about costumes for your skater's routine.
- Style your skater's hair neatly, away from her face. Secure and hair spray any loose ends. Stay away from bobby pins since they can fall out and become dangerous to the skaters on the ice.
- Expect it to be very cold. Have your skater bring warm layers and a blanket so he/she can keep warm before and after his/her routine.
- Advise friends and family to also dress warmly and bring blankets to keep warm during the show.
- Please don't send any colored drinks with your child since they can spill and stain the costumes. You can send bottled water with your child.
- When you arrive at the rink, drop your skater off in his/her assigned locker room. Below is the listing of the locker room assignments.  
**Locker Room 1:** Admirals, Adult Group, Solos, Duets & Trios not in a group or synchro  
**Locker Room 2:** Group 1 & 2  
**Locker Room 3:** Group 3, 4 & 5  
**Locker Room 4:** Topsails, Skipjacks & Sailors  
**Referee Room or Locker Room 5:** Men
- Tie your child's skates if he/she is unable to do so before the show. If your child has to change and needs help with his/her skates, you may go into the locker room to help him/her with this; however after you are done helping your child you will be asked to leave. Please don't walk in front of audience members when heading to and from the locker room. There will be locker room monitors in each room to help your child with anything else they may need.
- Skaters will sit in the locker rooms before and after their routines during the show. They may not leave the locker rooms for any reason. There are bathrooms in the locker rooms. Skaters can watch the show during Dress Rehearsal.
