2011 FIGURE SKATING CAMPS

TRACK ONE: BASIC 1 THRU BASIC 8

Track One is designed for those skaters who are currently working on Basic Skills in preparation for the freestyle level.



On-Ice Activities: The camp offers 3 hours of on-ice instruction per day which includes stroking, forward and backward crossovers, edges, three turns, mohawks, as well as choreography and an introduction to freestyle skills.

Off-Ice: Off-ice instruction includes stretching, conditioning, nutrition, goal setting, games, and arts and crafts.

TRACK TWO: FREESTYLE



Track Two is designed for those skaters who have passed the Basic 8 classes and are currently skating at the Freestyle level.

On-Ice Activities: The camp offers 3 hours of on-ice instruction per day which includes spins and jumps,

moves-in-the-field, stroking, footwork, choreography and style classes.

Off-Ice: Off-ice instruction includes stretching, strength and conditioning, nutrition, goal setting, games, and arts and crafts.

TRACK THREE: COMPETITIVE FREESTYLE

Track Three is designed for those skaters who are in Freestyle 6 and above and are looking for a more competitive track. On and Off-Ice activities will be similar to that of Track 2.

Program Philosophy: Ice World's summer camp program is a unique opportunity to increase competency through a program of class exercises, and a supportive team approach to improving skills. Now in our 15th year, we offer substantial ice time, while recognizing the importance of fun and recreational aspects of skating.

The camp has been designed for both Freestyle skaters and those skaters at the USFS Basic 1–Basic 8 levels. There are three camp options from which to choose.

Skaters will prepare and present a performance for their family and friends. The performance will be held at 2:30pm on Friday afternoon each week of camp.
